- 2. Sara wants to travel from Clapham Junction to Salisbury as quickly as possible. Which train should she catch? **08:58**
- 3. Tara lives in Yeovil and needs to be in Exeter by 12:30. What is the time of the latest train that she should catch? 11:08
- 4. Nathaniel travels from London Waterloo to Salisbury on the 07:10 train. How long is the journey? 1 hours 37 minutes
- 5. Emma lives 15 minutes away from Clapham Junction. She is meeting a friend in Exeter for lunch at 1pm. The restaurant is 35 minutes away from Exeter Central. What is the latest time that Emma should leave her house? **08:43**
- 6. Ethan travels to Exeter from Honiton to play rugby. Training starts at 12:30 sharp and he needs to allow 35 minutes to get from Exeter Central to the stadium. What is the time of the latest train that he should catch? 11:16
- 7. Will is waiting at London Waterloo for the 08:50 train to Salisbury when it's announced that there is a delay of 12 minutes. He also needs to catch a taxi at the station to his home. He allows 40 minutes for this. He texts his wife to let her know what time to expect him. What time does he put in the text? 11:09
