

**HCF: Highest Common Factor**

The factors of 12 are 1, 2, 3, 4, **6**, 12.

The factors of 30 are 1, 2, 3, 5, **6**, 10, 15, 30.

**The HCF of 12 and 30 is 6.** This is because it is the highest factor that is common to both.

**LCM: Lowest Common Multiple**

Multiples of 8 are 8, 16, **24**, 32, 40 ...

Multiples of 12 are 12, **24**, 36, 48, 60 ...

**The LCM of 8 and 12 is 24.** This is because it is the lowest multiple that is common to both.
